GERMAN TRANSPORTATION MINISTER A PRESS CONFERENCE ABOUT GERMANWINGS A320 CRASH

ALEXANDER DOBRINDT RESPONDS TO THE PRESS

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USPA NEWS - German Transport Minister Alexander Dobrindt, gave a press conference today following the one given by the prosecutor of Marseilles, Brice Robin to answer questions from journalists on the investigation of the crash of the A320 Germanwings.

THE GERMAN MINISTER AGREES ON THE STATEMENTS OF THE FRENCH PUBLIC PROSECUTOR OF MARSEILLE

The German Minister of Transport, Alexander Dobrindt, expressed dismay after receiving information from the French court about the Germanwings A320 crash: "The prosecution gave a lot of information that gave us the shivers".-----

"The captain could not get into the cockpit, it is a plausible thesis we are still waiting for the second black box, and this would allow us to confirm the assumptions of the first box, for audio recording. We are in close contact with Lufthansa and families and we are doing all that is possible. cooperation is excellent and cooperation will be strengthened in order to understand the origin of this terrible accident and make the necessary arrangements "then added German Minister of Transport.-----

Regarding the isolation of single co-pilot who remained alone in the cockpit, and without his captain (who was absent probably to satisfy a natural need), the Minister said "The doors operate so that we can always open door from the inside. from the inside there is a code with the code and even if it was locked from the inside, the door is blocked (International Regulations, all aircraft are equipped with this blocking doors).-----

He concluded: "For a commander leaving the cockpit it is ordinary, and the record of the black box, leaves us no information indicating that the captain left the cockpit after a discussion or words were exchanged with the co-pilot.
